### Policies, Rules and Regulations

### Membership Policy

- 1. Membership shall include all those persons who are permanent members of your household.
- 2. Electronic ID card must have a picture and birthdate for all members. Emergency information must be completed.
- 3. When entering the swim club, members must check in at the gate.

#### **Guest Policy**

- 1. Each membership is allowed to bring guests. All guests must be signed in by the pool member. Books of guest passes can be purchased at the gate, or paid through Venmo. Use of guest passes are tracked through Pool Pass. Guest fees are half price after 5 PM.
- 2. Guests must be accompanied by a pool member at all times. When the member leaves the pool, the guest must also leave. Guests must wear the wristband provided at the check-in.
- 3. Pool members are responsible for all actions of their guests.
- 4. For groups larger than 10 guests, please notify the pool manager ahead of time.
- 5. In the event of pool closure, a guest pass will be issued for guests who have been at the pool less than 2 hours.

# **General Policy**

- 1. The lifeguard must be on duty and the pool officially open before any user is allowed in the water.
- 2. All persons using the pool /pool area does so at their own risk and sole responsibility. Neither the management nor the Board of Directors assumes responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use. Management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any personal property.
- 3. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible party.

- 4. Lost and found items will be discarded twice each month, dates will be posted.
- 5. Wearing proper bathing attire is required. Street shoes, sneakers, flip-flops, cut-offs, walking shorts or indiscreet attire is not permitted in the pool.
- 6. All beverages or food brought into the pool area must be in paper or plastic containers. No glass of any kind is permitted. All trash must be disposed of in a trash container.
- 7. Misuse of a cell phone, phone camera, camera, and video camera is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Adult swims will be called on the hour when there are two guards in the chair. Adult swims are for 15 minutes. During adult swims, all persons under 18 years of age must vacate the pool. Please do not bring babies or toddlers in the water during an adult swim.
- 9. Smoking, vaping, electronic cigarettes and related products are not allowed on the upper grounds.
- 10. Any member may request the use of the lower pavilions or upper deck. Please see the manager to make a reservation.
- 11. Please exercise proper discretion and common sense when consuming alcohol on the pool premises. No one under 21 will be permitted to consume alcohol.
- 12. Lap lane is for lap swimming only.

## **Health Regulations**

- 1. All persons should shower before entering the pool.
- 2. Expectorating, nose blowing, spouting of water, eliminating of body waste and unhygienic acts into the pool are prohibited.
- 3. Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having infectious disease, sore or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, open sores or bandages of any kind.
- 4. No pets are allowed on the grounds at any time.
- 5. In the event of vomit, blood and/or fecal contamination, the pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations

#### Children

- 1. Parent/Guardian must closely watch children at all times.
- 2. Parent/Guardians are solely responsible for assessing and knowing their child's swimming ability. Please refer to General Safety Rule number 10 for swim test information.
- 3. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by and supervised by a member or designated guest 13 years or older who is present at all times.
- 4. Infant and toddlers wearing diapers or not toilet trained are permitted in the big pool if wearing swim diapers and tight-fitting rubber/waterproof pants. In the event of fecal contamination, the pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations.
- 5. Parents are responsible for the safety of their children when using the pool facilities.
- 6. Ball throwing and diving toys are permitted in the big pool when there is one guard in the chair.

## **Baby Pool**

- 1. This pool is intended for the use and enjoyment of younger children and their parents. Running, pushing, wrestling, or causing undue disturbance will not be tolerated. Older children who act inappropriately or jeopardize the safety of toddlers will be ejected from this area.
- 2. All children 8 years old and under must be accompanied by and supervised by a member or designee 13 years or older who is present at all times.
- 3. Play toys will be permitted in this pool only with adult supervision.

# **General Safety Regulations**

- 1. No glass of any kind is permitted on the pool grounds.
- 2. Water wings and inner tubes are prohibited at all times. For safety purposes, only a one-piece swim garment that is Coast Guard approved and snaps under the crotch is to be used. The child must be accompanied by someone 13 or over in the water.

- 3. Noodles are allowed at manager's discretion.
- 4. Running, pushing or wrestling or causing undue disturbance will not be permitted.
- 5. All personal injuries, however slight, must be reported to the manager.
- 6. No diving is allowed except in the diving well area.
- 7. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. Only one bounce is permitted. No flotation devices are allowed while jumping from the board. No diving or jumping toward the wall is permitted.
- 8. General swimming is allowed in the diving area only when the diving board is closed.
- 9. Gum chewing, food or beverages are not allowed in the pool.
- 10. Swimmers 15 years and younger must pass a swim test before swimming in the deep end of the pool. The deep-water swim test consists of swimming 2 lengths of the pool and treading water for 1 minute.
- 11. Obey posted speed limits and no parking signs at all times.
- 12. The emergency lane near the shed and the emergency gate entrance must remain clear at all times.
- 13. Ball playing on the upper grounds is at the discretion of the manager.
- 14. Personal canopies, umbrellas, and pop-up tents are allowed behind the first line of umbrellas around the pool.

All members are asked to observe the rules for use of Pine Ridge's pool and grounds. These rules have been compiled to benefit and protect all users of the pool facilities. Situations may arise where there are no applicable rules. In those cases, members will be expected to comply with the reasonable requests of the manager on duty.
